Originally built in 1918, The Broadmoor sits along the front range of the Colorado Rockies in Colorado Springs. We are a 5 Diamond, 5 Star property that prides itself on perfection. We have three championship golf courses which include the Mountain, East and West. The Mountain Course has been redesigned by the Nicklaus Design Group and opened for play in July 2006. The Mountain course boasts spectacular views of not just the mountains but the surrounding Colorado Springs area. The East and West golf courses are a combination design of both Donald Ross and Robert Trent Jones Sr. The West course is starting a three year renovation project that includes new bunkers, tees, water features, and greens expansions. The West course hosted the 1998 PGA Cup matches and is the most scenic of the three courses. The East Course has played host to some of the best golfers in the world with the 1959 and 1964 US Amateur, and the 1995 US Women's Open. The East course is known for its beautiful greens and is consistently ranked in the Top 100 golf courses in America. The Broadmoor is also ranked #9 golf resort in North America. The Broadmoor was recently the host site of the 2008 United States Senior Open and will be the host site of the 2011 United States Women's Open.
