- We need to get a prelim count on how many people would be interested in going to the conferences, such as STMA, and GCSAA, for next year so that we can look into funding and teams for the challenges
 - Brad and Travis are looking to start a 1 or 2 hour class next semester to train for the challenges. It would be a required class and would meet 1 time a week.
 - To be included in a team for a challenge the person would need to be a member of the organization
- Billy wants to look into getting business cards for everyone who is going to the conferences so that they can give them to contacts that they meet

- Billy is going to contact K-State to find out if they would be interested in creating a golf challenge between our schools
 - We would meet in a neutral course the night before, maybe to meet with the superintendent in the morning and get a tour of the facility and a small talk on how the course runs, then play the match around 11 or so.
- Brad is going to check into the possibility of selling shirts at the MVTA golf tourney on May 1st.
- We set May 4th, the Thursday before finals week, as the date for the end of the year BBQ, this will also be our last meeting of the year
