- Must learn the game of golf so that you are familiar with the rules, how to mark hazards and how a golf course should be set up
- Must have a commitment to personal and professional development with the desire to move ahead in the golf course management industry.
- Must keep a neat and professional appearance
- Must develop handwatering skills on greens to produce firm, fast greens without compromising the health of the turf.
- Upkeep of all safety records/NYSDEC records
- Assist with maintaining Audubon Sanctuary status
- Will scout for disease and insects in the A.M.
- Will pull out equipment in the A.M.
- Will work with the mechanic in the winter learning how to grind and set reels
